a term of not less than two months and not more than twelve months, or to both such fine and imprisonment."

5. Section 34 of the said Act is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

Regulations.

"34. The Governor in Council may make regulations for carrying out the purposes and provisions of this Act and in particular, but without restricting the generality of the foregoing, may make regulations

(a) for the proper management and control of the sea- 10

coast and inland fisheries;

(b) respecting the conservation and protection of fish;(c) respecting the catching, loading, landing, handling, transporting, possession and disposal of fish;

(d) respecting the operation of fishing vessels;

(e) respecting the use of fishing gear and equipment;(f) respecting the issue, suspension and cancellation of licences and leases;

(g) prescribing the terms and conditions under which a licence or lease is to be issued;

(h) respecting the obstruction and pollution of any waters frequented by fish;

(i) respecting the conservation and protection of spawning grounds;

(j) respecting the export of fish or any part thereof from 25 Canada;

(k) respecting the taking or carrying of fish or any part thereof from one province of Canada to any other province;

(l) prescribing the powers and duties of persons engaged 30 or employed in the administration or enforcement of this Act and providing for the carrying out of those duties and powers; and

(m) authorizing a person engaged or employed in the administration or enforcement of this Act to vary 35 any close time or fishing quota that has been fixed by the regulations."

6. Section 35 of the said Act is repealed.
