Born in Dublin, came with her family to White-wood, Sask.; her father was one of the six jurors at the trial of Louis Riel; married a rancher near Medicine Hat, 1899; during husband's illness had to ride the range, during which time she cultivated the muse; bought two stallions with the proceeds of her volume of verse.
