Line to and from the Right, Right Form.—On the word FORM, the leading section wheels to the right and halts. Each of the other sections marches a distance equal to its front beyond the wheeling point of the section just preceding it, then wheels to the right and forms in line on the left of its leading section and take up their dressing by the right.

112. — Being in Column of Sections, to March to the Right (or Left) in Line of Sections in Column of Files.

By Sections, Right (or Left)—Turn.—On the word TURN, all make a turn in the direction named and move on without checking the pace.

113. Being in Column of Sections to March to the Right (or Left) in Line of Sections in Columns of Threes.

By Sections, Threes-Right (or Left).—On the word RIGHT (or LEFT), all threes wheel to the right (or left).

114.—Being in Column of Sections to March to the Right (or Left) in Line of Sections in Column of Squads.

By Sections, Squads—Right (or Left).—On the word RIGHT (or LEFT), all squads wheel to the right (or left).
