Rule of ballot.

ART. 4.—The ballot shall take place between the hours of Ten A.M., and Six P.M., on the expiration of the fifteen days mentioned in the preceding article, such ballot to be continued daily until twenty-one members shall have voted. But no such ballot shall be closed before six o'clock on the day on which the twenty-first ball shall have been thrown.

New Mem-

ART. 5.—On the admission of each new member, the Secretary shall notify the same to him, and furnish him with a printed copy of the Constitution and Regulations, and request him to remit the amount of his subscription to the Treasurer.

Entrance and subscription.

ART. 6.—The entrance fee shall be Twenty pounds and the annual subscription Five pounds. The latter to be payable in advance on the First of April in each year. But the subscriptions of new members ballotted for on or after the 1st day of January in any year shall extend to the 1st day of April in the following year.

Members pay before voting.

ART. 7.—No member shall be admitted to vote on any occasion whatever or enjoy any of the privileges of the Club, until he shall have paid whatever entrance fee or subscription shall be due by him.

ART. 8.—Any member failing to pay his entrance on entrance, fee or subscription within six weeks after his admission, if he reside in Canada, or not farther south on the Continent of America than the 40th degree of north latitude, or within three months, if he reside else Con resi tary who list
