And whereas in the last session of parliament, three statutes were made : one intituled, " An act to discontinue in such manner, and " for such time as are therein mentioned, the " landing and discharging, lading or shipping " of goods, wares and merchandize, at the " town, and within the harbour of Bofton, " in the province of Massachusetts-Bay, in " North-America." Another intituled, " An " act for the better regulating the govern-" ment of the province of the Massachusetts-" Bay, in New-England." And another intituled, " An act for the impartial administration " of justice, in the cafes of perfons questioned " for any act done by them in the execution " of the law, or for the suppression of riots " and tumults, in the province of the Maffa-" chufetts-Bay, in New-England." And another statute was then made, " for making " more effectual provision for the government " of the province of Quebec, &c." All which statutes are impolitic, unjust and cruel, as well as unconstitutional, and most dangerous and destructive of American rights:
