6. No person shall, within the Town, exhibit or perform any Indecent, im-moral or lewd indecent, immoral or lewd play, or give any indecent exhibition; nlav. and the Mayor, Police Magistrate, the Chief of Police, or any constable or peace-officer, may prevent the exhibition or perfor-Exhibition may be premance of any such play, or the giving of any such exhibition. vented

Drunkenness.

7. No person shall be in a street, square, alley or public place within the Town in a state of drunkenness.

Houses of illfame or disorderly houses.

8. No person shall keep or frequent a house of ill-fame or disorderly house within the Town, or in any manner contribute to the support of such house or of any inmate thereof, or shall voluntarily reside therein.

Letting houses to be used as houses of illfame.

No person shall knowingly let any house or building within the Town, to be used as a house of ill fame, or knowingly and willingly permit the same to be so used.

Permitting houses to be sons.

10. No person shall permit his house or other building, within the Town, to be used, frequented, or resorted to by notornotorious per- ious persons, gamblers, vagrants, prostitutes or other persons of bad character.

Gaming.

11. No person shall keep a gambling-house within the Town, or keep or use, or permit to be kept or used, for the purpose of gambling, in any house, room or place within the Town, occupied by him, any faro bank, rouge et noir, roulette table, or any other device for gambling, or permit or allow any games of chance or hazard with dice, cards or other device, to be played for money, liquor or other thing within such house, room or place, and no person shall permit any description of gambling, playing at cards, dice or other games of chance with betting, in any such house, room or place; and no person shall frequent any such house, room or place, or gambling-house, or be therein for the purpose of gaming.

Mayor, etc., and destroy faro banks etc., found, therein.

12. The Mayor, Police Magistrate, the Chief of Police, or may enter gaming houses any constable, or peace officer, may enter into any house, room or place within the town, in which any faro bank, rouge et noir, roulette table, or other device for gambling, may be kept or used
