Imports from Germany amounted to 28,412,951 pounds, valued at \$629,307, which works out at about 2½ cents per pound. Imports from Canada amounted to 116,549,350 pounds, valued at \$6,747,403. The Canadian price to U. S. consumers is from 5 to 6½ cents per pound.

Montreal, Feb. 15.—The Star Shoe Co., Limited, of this city, today went into voluntary liquidation et the hands of Alexandre Desmarteau, authorized trustee, and notification to this effect was filed in the insolvency office of the superior court here. Liabilities are over \$300,000. Assets include the factory, goods in stock and book debts, the total of which has not yet been ascertained.
