MINUTES OF MEETING

(WESTERN SECTION)

OF THE

PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH IN CANADA.

TORONTO, 7TH AND 8TH OCTOBER, 1879.

At Toronto, and within the Deacons' Court Room of Knox Church there, on Tuesday, the 7th day of October, 1879, at 2 o'clock in the afternoon, the Home Mission Committee (Western Section) of the Presbyterian Church in Canada, met and was constituted with prayer. Rev. W. Cochrane, D.D., Convener, in the chair. The Committee continued in session till 10.30 p.m. on Wednesday, 8th October.
