TO THE COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC WORKS
AND MINES:

Sir,—

I have the honor to submit the customary Report of the Hospital for the Insane, embracing not only the records of the past year, but also the statistics of the whole period since its opening.

The admissions for 1870 have been seventy (70) in number, forty three (43) males, and twenty seven (27) females. The entire number under care this year has been three hundred and fifteen (315).

Fifty-five (55) have been discharged; thirty (30) males, and twenty five (25) females, leaving on our record at the close of the year two hundred and sixty (260), being fifteen (15) more than at the end of 1869.
