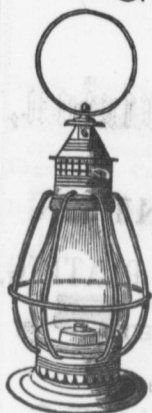

This Truss possesses the following advantages which render it superior to all others, viz.: 1st. Its ease of adjustment; the Pad moving freely upon a ball and socket joint, finds its proper bearing upon the body, and can then be retained in place by means of the thumb-screw. 2d. It can be made to fit either right or left side: an important consideration to those Dealers who keep but a small stock on hand. 3rd. Its lightness and elegance; rendering it the most attractive Truss yet offered to the public. 4th. The ease with which it can be worn. a a represents the Steel Spring encircling the body. b, the arm connecting Spring and Pad. c, the Pad playing upon which it can be worn. Those the end of a lever lying under the plate of Pad c. d, a ball resting in a cup or socket in who have once used this Truss checked socket in its upper end firmly against the ball d, thus can never be induced to go back holding the Pad securely in whatever position it is placed. to the old styles.
