# History of Oleo

Believes Farmers Should Not Ob. ject so Strenueusly to Its Being Marketed-"Foolish and Injuri-

Editor of The Toronto Star Weekly: In a recent issue of The Star Weekly I read an interesting article on oleo-margarine, what it was, and how it came to be excluded from use as a food product in Canada.

product in Canada.

Few men have had a more extended experience in the sale and use of oleomargarine than myself, who for upwards of thirty years disposed of about three-quarters of a million pounds annually under a wholesaler's license under the regulations of the United States Rev-

regulations of the United States Revenue Department.

Oleomargarine came on the market with little introduction, which led unscrupulous dealers to offer it as butter. The American Dairymen's Association, which is one of the strongest combinations in the country, thought they saw in oleomargarine a dangerous competitor for creamery butter, and set about to hamper its sale through legislation, which led the federal government to place a tax of two cents per pound upon its manufacture, together with a charge of \$40 for a license to sell it at retail and \$400 for a wholesale license.
