DUNHAM LADIES' COLLEGE.

The Corporation of this Institution finding itself unable at present, for want of means, to open the College on the basis originally contemplated, and believing it to be most important that the work of instruction should be entered upon with as little delay as possible, have made arrangements, for the time being, with Miss Brandford Griffith, now Mrs. Oakley, to open a school in the College building, under the patronage of the Corporation. The staff of Teachers under Mrs. Oakley as Lady Principal, are nine in number and of the highest qualifications, and comprise Rev. R. D. Mills, M. A., Rector of Dunham, and Rev. T. H. G. Watson, M. A., Oxon. The Lady Principal makes every effort to furnish a thorough and complete education, and the expense of board and tuition has been placed at the lowest estimate consistent with the solvency of the Institution. During the past year the number of pupils has ranged from forty to fifty.

MISSION FUND.

Missionary Meetings have been held generally in every Incumbency in the Deanery, and every influence has been exerted to enkindle a zealous interest in behalf of this Fund. Some Parishes, notably Abbottsford and St. John's, have largely supplemented the amounts they were expected to contribute, but, owing to the unsettled state of other Parishes, induced by changes or vacancies, it is feared that there will be a considerable deficiency in the sum the Deanery, as a whole, ought to have placed to the credit of the Fund. Returns have not been supplied from all the Parishes, and it is, therefore, impossible to estimate the exact deficiency.
