LONDON, Dec. 31.—A third disappearance case has arisen to occupy the British police, just recovering from their searches for the novelist, Agatha Christie, who turned up at a Yorkshire Spa, and Miss Una Crowe, who drowned herself in the sea off the Dorset Coast. This time it is the Honorable Lawrence Edward Bromfield Falk, 40, son and heir of the third Baron Haldon. His father told the police that Falk left his office, in the city, Tuesday afternoon, intending to take a train for Croydon, near London, where he had an apartment. He did not appear at the apartment and has not been heard from since. He carried an unspecified sum of money.
