TO DATE OF THIS LETTER.

Sir,

About 4 P.M. Jan 2^d 1912 a report came to my office that there had been foul play at the house of Chas Nahdee on Squirel Island. I went down at once and found that there had been some shooting done and that two persons Chas Nahdee and Adam John were missing. Shots had been fired through the window and there was a lot of blood on the stairs and floor and every indication that a crime had been committed. There was a trail from the house to the river where two bodies had been dragged to the river upon making inquiries of the neighbors I found that four parties had been in the house drinking that evening Chas Nahdee Adam John Steven Kujoshk and Percy Williams. I came back home and sent an officer to St. Lambert to notify Mr J.P. Buick county attorney of the matter and I offered a reward of \$10⁰⁰ each for the recovery of the bodies. The body of Adam John has been recovered he was found in the St. Clair river opposite the house. The Indian Steven Kujoshk and the woman Percy Williams that were at the house Jan 1st 1912 have been locked up and I do not think that there is any doubt but that they are the guilty parties. owing to the winds the parties had to stop dragging the bodies but will commence again as soon as it
