WILL ERECT A NURSES' WARD

JUBILEE HOSPITAL MAKES ARRANGEMENTS

City Council Will Be Asked for Increased Grant—Matters of Interest Discussed.

The board of managers of the Provincial Royal Jubilee hospital occupied much of their time in discussing the proposed new home for nurses, at the monthly meeting held Tuesday evening.

Arrangements are now well advanced for the erection of this home, as the subject has been under consideration for some time past.

The plan of the building as submitted to the board shows the following: Thirty bedrooms, each 10 to 12 feet square, with large sitting-room, one head nurse's sitting-room, one study and one small reception-room, one trunk-room, one, small kitchen. The building will be constructed on the most modern plan, and will be fitted throughout with up-to-date conveniences.

The whole matter of the plans for the new home was left in the hands of the house committee, with the understanding that a report will be submitted at the next meeting of the board.

It was decided to appeal to the city council for an increased grant to the hospital, which has been inspected by the United States congressional party, which has been inspecting the work done on the Panama canal.

PROVINCIAL RIGHTS PARTY.

Mr. Haultain and His Followers in Saskatchewan Adopt Platform.

Regina, March 19.—The Provincial Rights party of the province met in convention to-day under the presidency of Mr. Haultain and adopted the following platform:

Provincial organization: That this convention hereby declares that the Provincial Rights party of the province of Saskatchewan is purely a provincial organization, formed for the purpose of securing full powers of provincial self-government subject to and in accordance with the provisions of the B. N. A. Act.

Purity of elections: That the convention hereby declares against bribery and all fraudulent schemes to defraud the honest purpose of the electors as being a violation of the fundamental principles of responsible government, and pledges itself to secure, maintain and enforce effective legislation, whereby election trials shall be speedily brought on and prosecuted to a conclusion without regard to party or personal consideration.

That the lands, timber and minerals of the province rightfully belong to the province, and should be administered by the provincial government in the interests of the people of the province.

That the ownership and control of the public resources of the province should not only mean an incalculable addition to the available assets of the province, which would obviate the necessity for resorting to direct taxation, but would also enable the provincial authorities to effectually deal with the conditions to which may be attributed the great loss and suffering caused by the shortage in fuel during the past few months, and to materially check the evils resulting from any lumber combine.

None of the members of the opposition were present in the legislative assembly to-day, in consequence of a meeting of the Provincial Rights party.

Jews fleeing FROM RUMANIA

FURTHER OUTRAGES BY PEASANTS FEARED

Report Town Has Been Set on Fire—Authorities Appeal For Troops.

Vienna, March 19.—According to a telegram received here from Charnowitz, an Austrian town close to the boundary of Moldavia, Rumania, advices have been received there from the Austrian frontier police at Izkkanua that the anti-Jewish outbreak in Rumania is assuming serious proportions.

Other reports say further disturbances have occurred at Botoshani, where the peasants have set fire to the houses of Jews, and as a result the entire town is in flames.

The Hebrew alliance of Vienna is preparing to take care of the Rumanian fugitives.




