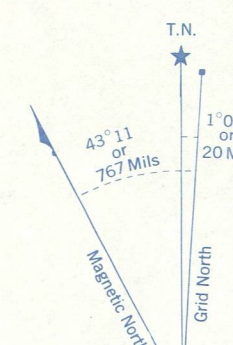
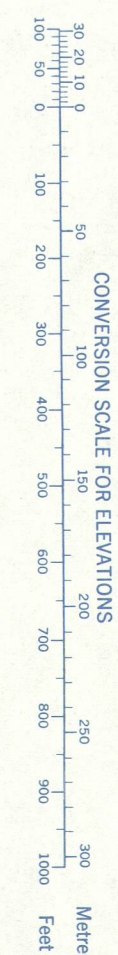

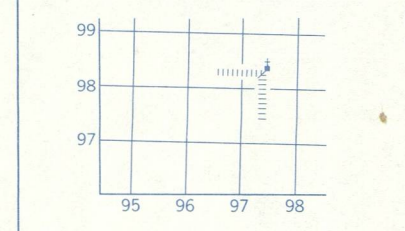

EXAMPLE OF METHOD USED TO GIVE A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 100 METRES. THE FOLLOWING GRID REFERENCE IS A SIMPLE ONE AND DOES NOT REFER TO A POINT ON THE MAP.



REFERENCE POINT	CHURCH (see above)
EASTING: Read number on grid line immediately to left of point. Estimate tenths of a square from this line eastward to point.	97 97.5
NORTHING: Read number on grid line immediately below point. Estimate tenths of a square from this line northward to point.	98 98.4

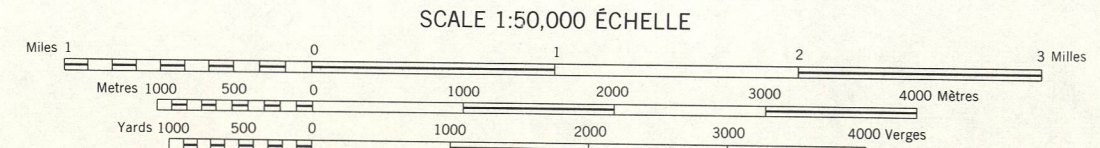
EXAMPLE MILITARY GRID REFERENCE: 975984. Nearest similar grid reference: 100,000 metres (about 63 miles).
