BERLIN, Sept. 17-The indictment brought by Prof. Fritsch, of Prague, during the South American Congress at Vienna, against the Berlin ethno-logical museum, and his charges of inhuman treatment of Indians by German settlers in the Province of Santa Catharina, who, he alleged, bought Indian children for the purpose of slavery, have aroused intense indignatively way west of Lake Abitibi for which way west of Lake Abitibi for which

slavery, have aroused intense indignation in Germany.

Replying to the allegation, the museum authorities say that Prof. Fritsch has had little experience in Berlin. He undertook an exploring expedition to the interior of that country at his own risk and expense. If the journey were successful, the museum was to commission him for a second journey. He, however, made himself impossible by founding a league for the protection of the Indians, and by otherwise agitating against the Germans in Brazil. Dr. Da Costa-Motta, the Brazilian Minister here, repudiates the charge of slavery in Brazil.
