

LA VIE CATHOLIQUE

L'œuvre missionnaire en LE CHRIST-ROI AUX INDES

Berlin. — Avant la guerre, l'Allemagne occupait la seconde place au point de vue de l'importance des missions qui étaient confiées à ses religieux. 318 prêtres, aidés par 216 clercs et Frères, et 320 Sœurs religieuses d'origine allemande, avaient à s'occuper de 588,000 catholiques.

Ces colonies ayant été perdues par l'Allemagne, les missionnaires allemands n'en non pas moins repris leur activité en d'autres territoires. Ils évangélisent actuellement la Chine, la Corée, la Mandchourie, et depuis quelques temps certaines régions de l'Afrique orientale.

Une branche spéciale de l'Action catholique allemande en ce domaine a trait à la fourniture, aux missionnaires, de moyens modernes de locomotion: bateaux à vapeur, automobiles, avions, etc. Un comité spécial a été constitué à cet effet, sous la présidence d'un Oblat, le P. Schuller qui a été aviateur pendant la guerre.
