PRELIMINARY PROCEEDINGS.

Pursuant to notice issued by Bro. J. P. Young, District Deputy Grand Sire, a meeting of the Representatives of the several Subordinate Lodges of the Independent Order of Odd-Fellows, in the Province of Manitoba, was held in the Lodge Room of Portage Lodge, No. 3, Portage la Prairie, on the afternoon of Wednesday, the first day of August, 1883, for the purpose of considering the propriety of applying to the Sovereign Grand Lodge of the L. O. O. F. at its next session, for a Charter for a Grand Lodge, to be known as the Grand Lodge of Manitoba.

The D. D. G. Sire took the chair at two o'clock P.M., and called the meeting to order.
