I have received your letter of April 2nd, 1949,
in regard to road work, St. Regis Agency. For your information,
I would say that the following are the sums provided for road
work:

Repairs to Cornwall Island Road	- \$	300.00
Repairs to St. Regis Village Road	-	700.00
Repairs to Chamail Road	-	<u>11,500.00</u>
Total	- \$	12,500.00

The sum of \$12,500.00 is being encumbered and, as
requested in your letter above referred to, \$500.00 is being sent
to you to take care of emergency repairs caused by spring floods.
It will be necessary for you to account for this money before
any further funds are advanced. If any materials, supplies or
equipment have to be purchased, they will have to be charged
against the above sum, and you should requisition for them
sufficiently in advance to have them on hand when you wish to
proceed with the major portion of the work.
