M., 27 Jan., 1885, Katie Jeannette, only dau. of the late Thos. Hume, of Halifax. Called to the Bar, N.S., 8 Dec., 1877. Was one of the Ex. Committee of the Cape Breton Exhibitions in 1880 and 1884. Is a Trustee of the Baddeck Academy and has been Clerk to the Municipality of Victoria. Sat in the Nova Scotia Assem. from g.e., 1882, until g.e., 1886, when he was not a candidate. S. of Dougald McDongald and Elizabeth Fraser. Ancestors came from Inverness-shire, Scot. B. in Blue Mountain, Pictou Co. N.S., 13 March, 1848. Ed. at New Glasgow Grammar Sch. A merchant. M., 9 Nov., 1882, Maggie J. McLeod, of Westville. Appted. a J. P. in 1879. Elected County Councillor of the Municipal Council of Pictou Co. in 1879, and subsequently in 1880, 1882 and 1884. First returned to Parlt. 18 June, 1881, on the elevation of Hon. James McDonald to the Office of Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of NS. Re-elected at g.e. 1882, and again at g.e. 1887.
