

lity within which the same shall be situate, as the Municipal Council of such Municipality, shall deem proper to order.

XXXII. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for the Overseers in each Parish or Township, or the majority of them, at their annual meeting for determining upon and fixing the winter roads, to order the fences to be taken down along the by-roads where it may be necessary, for the said winter roads, and to cause them to be put up again as soon as possible after the winter season, in as good a state as they were previous to their being taken down; and such fences shall be taken down and put up again by the parties interested in the said Roads; Provided always, that it shall not be lawful for the said Overseers, or the majority of them, to cause to be taken down any palisade, whether made with rails, or of stone, nor any quickset hedge.

Fences may be taken down by Overseers for the purpose of winter roads.

Proviso.

XXXIII. And whereas doubts have arisen as to certain By-Laws of the former Parish or Township Councils; Be it declared and enacted that all By-Laws made by the said Parish or Township Councils, or by any Committee of any Parish or Township Council, which shall not have been repealed nor amended by the Councils of Counties or of Divisions of Counties, shall have full force and effect, and shall continue to have full force and effect until the same shall be repealed or amended by competent authority.

Doubts as to By-laws of former Parish, Councils removed.

XXXIV. And be it enacted, That every part of any Act or Law repugnant to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Act shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Parts of Acts repugnant to this repealed.

XXXV. And be it enacted, That the Interpretation Act shall apply to this Act.
