

for the Post of Amherstburg was very
considerable yet it will not be sufficient
owing to the immense number of distant
Indians that have visited that Post this
year, it is impossible to ascertain
to a certainty, the quantity that may be
required each year, it depends entirely
on the success of their hunting, the
supplies they receive from the Trader
& their crops, should those fail, the numbers
that visit the Kings Posts is very great,
on the contrary, should they be well supplied
& their crops & hunt good, - these last two
years I believe they have been in want
of every supply from the Trader -
