

Following publication of a letter from Dr. H.A. Bruce, member for Parkdale indicating his preference for a Government devoid of party considerations I also wrote Dr. Bruce urging he seek Jachman and co-operate to bring about this great aid to Britain.

I have also written Hon. R.B. Hanson urging he resign and disband the Conservative Party thus making way for some really Democratic organization.

On the ordinary course of events Mr. Jachman and Hon. R.B. Hanson should have received my letters in March 17th. No reply to date, and no manuscripts have come back.

Another point of contact with Capt. White. During the election campaign when Capt. White was first elected, certain reflections were made on the conduct of Ontario Liberals, and Hon. Earl Rowe sent one of his assistants for conference with me, and I loaned him pages and pages of material. To get this material returned, I believe I did finally suggest court action. But Conservatives of Ontario again acting as accomplices to this Foreign Financial Control Group by remaining silent. It would be impossible for me to take court action against Jachman for failure to return my articles as though I have ten applications in to Civil Service I am still Dis-employed and on Relief or I would use better paper, and pay the postage.
