I beg to acknowledge the receipt of the statements of lots sales and collections in the Townsite of Kamsack for January and February, and have to call your attention to the January Return and Lot 2- Block 7 therein entered, and to say that this lot was sold to Frank W. Walker on the 3rd May 1907 and it still remains on the Books in his name, but the return shows A. Renaud to be the purchaser and the payer of the amount recorded.


Lot 1, Block 9 was sold on the 24th August 1906 to W.S. Stinson and the Department has no record of an assignment from him to A. Renaud, who is entered in the return as the purchaser and payer of an instalment.

Before the payments received will be entered, you will be good enough to furnish the Department with an Assignment from the original purchasers or state that the payment may be placed to the credit of the original purchasers.

The February return shows that Adelard Renand purchased Lot 27, Block 4 and gives no date of the sale or any of the sales that took place in February. Should not the name Renand be Renaud?
