In reply to your letter of the 30th ultimo, in further reference to your complaint that your Company supplied lumber to the value of \$112.00 for the Metlakatla Agency for which payment has not been made, I beg to say that the Department has been making enquiry through its officers in regard to the matter, but has not as yet received a report. Particular attention is again being directed thereto, and it is expected that an immediate report will be made. I may say that there is no intention on the part of the Department to withhold payment provided the claim is found to be just. Settlement can not, however, be made until a properly certified voucher is received. When the report now looked for is received no time will be lost in attending to the matter.
