

in Council to pay such fees to  
the Receiver General of Canada.

And the second Resolution,  
which provides for the punishment  
of proflegacy, the Deputy Minister  
of Justice is of opinion, is open  
to the objections:

1. That the term "proflegacy"  
is in meaning so general and  
indefinite that there would  
be difficulty in enforcing the  
regulation; and 3<sup>rd</sup> that the  
penalty should be prescribed  
in terms.

I am also advised that  
there is no authority for any  
Court or Magistrate returning  
to the Provincial Treasury fees  
collected under the Indian Act.
