I am in reacipt of your letter of the End instant, with which you enclosed a requisition for wood, conl all etc. for use in your office and also for use by the constable, and in reply I beg to any that the articles which you have asked for for yourself may be purchased. No provision has been make for the supply of the articles asked for for the constable, and you should not have taken for granted that they would be supplied. The constable is paid salary at the rate of \$75,00 a math, and is emittled to mottics of liquor fines, and also to his estual traveling expenses. He should provide his own fuel and fight. As his supplies his out smongst the Indians the granter part of the time, his expenses in this sonnection should not be large.
