First Witness for Defense on 2nd Charge.
The accused, states:

I was proceeding home to my
barracks after the dance on 19 Aug 43.
with Pte Parsley, Lanthier. We got a
lift home in an American truck. We got
off at a road toward our camp. Ptes.
Parsley & Lanthier were walking at the
right hand of the road & I was on the left.
We were not involved in any fight whatsoever
even from the time we left the truck
until we came in contact with an
English soldier & an A.T.S. girl

Cross Exam:

We got off the truck about a mile
from camp. I did not see Pte Davidson, the last
witness, at all that night. I heard
his evidence. Lanthier, Parsley & I were
alone after the A.T.S. girl. Pte Butler came
with us.

By the Court: Davidson's evidence is not
true. We did not get into any fracas
from the time we left the dance hall,
except the one which is the subject of
the 2nd charge.

The evidence is read over to the accused.
Second Witness for Defense on 2nd Charge.
K 62652 Pte Butler, P. W. sworn states:

On the night of 19 Aug 43 I returned
from a dance at Amesbury. I came
back in the last truck of an American
