

The Department will endeavour to expedite the matter, but you will understand that the interests of the Indians must be carefully considered and protected. If, however, the terms and conditions set forth herein are approved by your client, Dr. Bruner, and advice to this effect is sent to us by telegram, the necessary surrender documents will be prepared at once and forwarded to our local Agent, with instruction to submit them to the Indians for approval or otherwise, without delay.
