Since 1915 a large number of logging outfits and several saw mills have been established to the south along the Lake Windermere branch and these mills are gradually extending their operations northward.

ATTRACTIONS

On account of its natural beauty the District is already favorably known to tourists, and its attractions will be further materially developed in the near future by the completion of the Banff Windermere Motor Road. A trunk road runs right through the Windermere District between Golden and Cranbrook; from this there are many lateral roads already built extending up the various rivers and creeks already mentioned. All are good motor roads.

The warm waters of Lake Windermere are peculiarly attractive for bathing and boating. There is excellent hunting and fishing, and there is a nine hole golf course at Invermere.
