

that they treat each other at all times with due delicacy and respect; and in particular, that all their discussions in Lodge be conducted in a spirit of candor, moderation, and generosity, and that all personalities and sarcastic language be carefully avoided.

ARTICLE XI.—AMENDMENTS.

No motion to repeal, suspend, or amend these By-laws or any part thereof, shall be put to vote until the same shall have been read in Lodge at three consecutive regular meetings; nor shall the consideration of, or the voting upon, any such motion be postponed after such third reading, unless by vote of the Lodge; nor shall such motion be declared to prevail, unless, upon the final division thereon, two-thirds of the brothers present and voting, shall vote in favor of it, unless by unanimous vote of the Lodge.
