The interest that has been taken in this case since it came before the Courts (Civil and Criminal), the extraordinary efforts on the part of Mr. Alexander Seath and his Counsel, to establish the genuineness of the Promissory Notes in question, and the contradictory sworn testimony of the principal witnesses are of such importance to the commercial public, that I deem it proper, as well as an act of justice to myself, to publish herewith a full *verbatim* report of the Judgment delivered in the Superior Court, on Saturday, the 14th day of April last, by His Honor Justice Rainville, declaring the Note sued upon a Forgery, which will, I trust, set at rest all further conflicting opinions in this *cause célèbre*, and place me right in the regard of all honest thinking men.
