HINDENBURG LINE SHATTERED SUPREME EFFORT OF BRITISH TROOPS

Yesterday's Offensive Was Probably Most Notable Blow of War; British Advance Was Irresistible and Number of Villages Fell

Field Marshal Haig has sprung a surprise on the Germans in Northern France, attacking suddenly on a front of more than 30 miles and breaking the famous Hindenburg line to a maximum depth of nearly five miles. His troops are still fighting their way forward in the most spectacular offensive of war on the western front since the trench lines were established.
