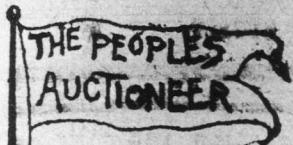

#### French Consulate.

##### NOTICE.

The FRENCH GOVERNMENT is purposing to subsidize a POSTAL LINE intended to carry mails and freight to and from SAINT PIERRE from and to the Ports of HALIFAX and SYDNEY.

This provides for fortnightly calls at HALIFAX all the year round, and at SYDNEY from the 1st of May to the 31st of December. The steamer would be allowed calls at several other ports of the UNITED STATES, CANADA and NEWFOUNDLAND provided no delay be suffered by the carrying of the mail and freight.

Tenders for the service should be sent through the FRENCH CONSUL here to the ADMINISTRATOR of SAINT PIERRE, not later than the 6th of December next.

Forms for application and all particulars will be furnished, on application, by the FRENCH CONSULATE, 49 Cochrane Street, between the hours of 11 and 12 a.m.

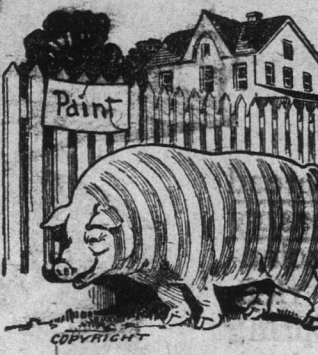
