of Canada must make the required monthly contributions to social security programs to maintain their eligibility for such benefits.

9.1. Canada Pension Plan

The diplomatic or consular mission is encouraged to arrange with the Provincial and International Relations Division of the Taxation Branch of the Department of National Revenue to provide coverage under the Canada Pension Plan for its locally engaged employees who are permanent residents of Canada.

If the diplomatic or consular mission chooses not to deduct the required monthly contributions, its locally engaged employees must request to make them directly by completing form CPT-20, <u>Election to Pay Canada Plan Contributions</u>.

9.2. Quebec Pension Plan

Locally engaged employees of consular missions in Quebec must make the required monthly contributions to the Quebec Pension Plan. Information and forms may be obtained from the Office of Protocol of the Ministry of International Relations of Quebec.

9.3. Unemployment Insurance

Locally engaged employees of diplomatic and consular missions who are permanent residents of Canada must make the required monthly contributions for unemployment insurance in order to be eligible for unemployment benefits.

10. Protective Security for Diplomatic and Consular Missions
