The Lieutenant-Governor presents The Premier of Saskatchewan (Hon. T. C. Douglas) and Mrs. Douglas, the Mayor of Regina (H. P. Baker, Esquire) and Mrs. Baker.

Her Majesty is escorted to the dais by Lieutenant-Governor.
