## McDOUGALL TO GIVE CANADIAN STATEMENT TO UNITED NATIONS GENERAL ASSEMBLY

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Barbara McDougall, today announced that she will head the Canadian delegation to the 46th United Nations General Assembly in New York.

"Canada's commitment in favour of a strong United Nations is universally recognized," said Mrs. McDougall. "Our greatest priority at this 46th session is to make the UN stronger, more efficient and more relevant to today's challenges."

Mrs. McDougall will deliver her speech on Wednesday, September 25. She will also take advantage of her visit to New York to hold bilateral meetings with several of her counterparts and to attend a number of multilateral meetings.
