"8. Except in quantities and under conditions prescribed with respect to waste disposal in a water quality management area, no person shall deposit or permit the deposit of waste of any type in any waters or in any place under any conditions where such waste or any other waste that results from the deposit of such waste may enter any such waters."

After further debate, the question being put on the said motions, pursuant to section 11 of Standing Order 75, recorded divisions were deferred.

Mr. Greene, seconded by Mr. Laing (Saskatoon-Humboldt), moved,—That Bill C-144, An Act to provide for the management of the water resources of Canada including research and the planning and implementation of programs relating to the conservation, development and utilization of water resources be amended by striking out lines 40 to 43 on page 10 and substituting the following therefor:

"(c) the loans or contributions in respect of the cost of incorporation and operating expenses of the agency and the loans in respect of capital costs incurred by the agency that is to undertake the program, that"

Mr. Greene, seconded by Mr. Laing (Saskatoon-Humboldt), moved,—That Bill C-144, An Act to provide for the management of the water resources of Canada including research and the planning and implementation of programs relating to the conservation, development and utilization of water resources be amended by striking out lines 44 to 47 on page 16 and line 1 on page 17 and substituting the following therefor:

"(4) Except with respect to loans authorized to be made by it by the Minister or a provincial government as described in paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of section 10, an agency does"

Mr. Greene, seconded by Mr. Laing (Saskatoon-Humboldt), moved,—That Bill C-144, An Act to provide for the management of the water resources of Canada including research and the planning and implementation of programs relating to the conservation, development and utilization of water resources be amended by striking out lines 5 and 6 on page 18 and substituting the following therefor:

"the agency, in respect of its operating expenses or in respect of capital costs incurred by it, and"
