

BY-LAWS
OF THE
Toronto Curling and Skating Club.

ADOPTED BY THE PROVISIONAL DIRECTORS OF THE SAID CLUB AT
A MEETING HELD AT THE WALKER HOUSE, IN THE CITY OF
TORONTO, ON THE 30TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, A.D. 1874.

WHEREAS, by the "Ontario Joint Stock Companies Letters Patent Act of 1874," 37 Vict. Cap. 35," the said Toronto Curling and Skating Club was incorporated, and by the seventh section of Letters Patent incorporating the said Club, the Provisional Directors were authorized from time to time to pass such rules, regulations and by-laws as may be deemed expedient :

AND WHEREAS, it is necessary and expedient that rules and by-laws should be adopted so as to regulate the proceedings of the Directors' and shareholders' meetings, from time to time, as well touching the management and disposition of the stock, property, estate and effects of the said Club, as well the duties of its officers, clerks, and servants, their appointments, wages, and salaries, and also such other matters and things as shall apper-
