and inclusive only of those returned to the Dominion Command as members for whom per capita tax is paid to the end of the quarter immediately preceding the convention.

(1) Each local branch shall be entitled to send to the convention, as representing its members, one delegate, and in addition one delegate for the next three hundred members above the first one hundred, and thereafter one delegate for each additional complete five hundred members.

Voting.

(2) Where no poll is demanded the vote of the convention shall be by yea and nay, or by a standing vote.

Where a poll is demanded each branch shall, on any question, have one vote for every member as defined above.

When more than one delegate voting for a branch.

(3) Where delegates from any branch disagree on any question being polled, each of such delegates shall have the voting power of the number of delegates present from that branch, divided into the membership of that branch as above defined.

Several branches uniting on delegate.

(4) Where two or more branches voluntarily combine to send a single delegate, he shall carry credentials from each of the branches accrediting him and be entitled to cast the vote of each of such branches.

Executive.

(5) Irrespective of whether they have been re-elected as delegates, the Dominion Executive shall be fully qualified members of the convention until its close. Where no poll is demanded they shall vote in the same manner as above set forth. Where a poll is demanded they shall not vote unless delegates.

Sec. 48.—At each session of any convention, the following committees shall be elected, whose powers and duties shall terminate with the adjournment of the convention for the year:—
