HOG PRICES LOWER MONTREAL YARDS CATTLE UNALTERED

Large Volume of Business Transacted at Union Stock Yards on Holiday

OFFERINGS QUITE FREE

Best Steers and Heifers Quickly Bought-Top Price Nine Dollars

Receipts of live stock at the Union Stock Yards yesterday were 140 cars—2249 cattle, 1926 hogs. 851 sheep and lambs and 396 calves.

It will be seen by the sales given that there were a few cattle sold at \$9; but, as usual lately, the bulk of those on sale were of common and medium quality.

Trade was quite active, considering that ft was a holiday and prices were steady, but firm.

There was one buyer from Montreal, but he said prices were too high for him to do any business.

In all the different classes of live stock there was little change in prices, excepting for hogs, which were 25c per cwt. Butchers' Cattle.

Choice heavy steers by the load sold at \$8.60 to \$9; loads of good, \$8.25 to \$8.50; medium to good, \$7.75 to \$8.15; medium, \$7.50 to \$7.75; common to medium, \$7.25 to \$7.50; inferior heifers, \$6.50 to \$7; choice cows, \$6.75 to \$7; good cows, \$6.25 to \$6.50; medium cows, \$5.75 to \$6; common cows, \$3 to \$4.50; choice bulls, \$6.75 to \$7.50; common bulls, \$5. to \$6.25.

Choice steers, 800 to 900 lbs., are selling at \$7.50 to \$7.75; good steers, 600 to 700 lbs., at \$6.75 to \$7.25; stockers, \$5.50 to \$6.50




