Your Committee recommend as follows :-

1. That the Rev. S. J. Thompson be appointed Secretary of the Board of Examiners.

2. That John Jessop, Esq., of Victoria, B.C., be Treasurer of the

Educational Fund.

3. That we reaffirm the recommendation of last year, viz. :—"That the 15th day of January be the day when all Examination Papers shall be in the hands of the Secretary of the Board of Examiners, and that he be instructed to forward them immediately to the Chairmen of Districts.

4. That the paper of R. B. Beavis, on Rhetoric in the Second Year's course of study, having been lost in transmission from the Chairman of the District to the Secretary of the Board of Examiners, he be allowed in that subject a standing equal to the average marks made by him in the other subjects of the year.

5. That, in accordance with the recommendation of the Westminster District, Wm. D. Misener be appointed to attend Victoria College, and

that a grant of \$20 be made him for College fees.

6. That, in accordance with the recommendation of Simpson District, Reuben B. Beavis be appointed to attend Victoria College, that a grant of \$20 be made him for College fees, and that he be granted a loan of \$150 on the terms imposed by Discipline.

7. That the President and Secretary of Conference, and Rev. E. Robson, be a committee to arrange a Course of Study for the Chinese candi-

dates for the ministry.

8. We recommend that the Board of Examiners be the same as last year, with the addition of the name of Rev. Chas. Ladner.
