EVENING PRAYER.

¶ The Service is to begin by the Ministers reading the same Sentences that were read in the Morning.

¶ Then follows the Hymn which was used at Morning Prayer, instead of the Venite, &c.

¶ Proper Psalms, LXXVII. and LXXXVI.

¶ First Lesson, Jeremiah, XVIII. 1—11.

My soul doth magnify the Lord, &c. St. Luke, L. 46.

¶ Second Lesson, Romans, II.

God be merciful unto us, &c. Psalm LXVII.

¶ Then the Creed, &c. to the end of the Lord's Prayer.

¶ Then follow the Petitions, as in the Morning Service.
Priest. O Lord, shew Thy mercy upon us;
Answ. And grant us Thy salvation, &c.

¶ Instead of the first Collect for Evening Prayer, the same Collect that was used in the Morning Service, O Lord God Almighty, &c.

¶ The second Collect at Evening Prayer,

O God from whom all Holy desires, &c.

The third Collect. Lighten our darkness we beseech Thee O Lord, &c.
