EVENING PRAYER.

¶ *The Service is to begin by the Ministers reading the same Sentences that were read in the Morning.*

¶ *Then follows the Hymn which was used at Morning Prayer, instead of the Venite, &c.*

¶ *Proper Psalms, LXXVII. and LXXXVI.*

¶ *First Lesson, Jeremiah, XVIII. 1—11.*

My soul doth magnify the Lord, &c. *St. Luke, L. 46.*

¶ *Second Lesson, Romans, II.*

God be merciful unto us, &c. *Psalm LXVII.*

¶ *Then the Creed, &c. to the end of the Lord's Prayer.*

¶ *Then follow the Petitions, as in the Morning Service.*

Priest. O Lord, shew Thy mercy upon us ;

Answ. And grant us Thy salvation, &c.

¶ *Instead of the first Collect for Evening Prayer, the same Collect that was used in the Morning Service, O Lord God Almighty, &c.*

¶ *The second Collect at Evening Prayer,*

O God from whom all Holy desires, &c.

¶ *The third Collect.*—Lighten our darkness we beseech Thee O Lord, &c.
