

Argentine Cable. The production is officially placed on the Argentine crop at 136,000,000 bushels, with an exportable surplus of 82,800,000 bushels. The oats crop is placed at 42,-750,000 bushels. Note-Broomhall's former estimate of the exportable surplus for wheat has been reduced 41,000,000, and is now placed at 101,000,000 bushels. 


