Deputation Urges That Flat Rate on Lands Would Discourage the Prospector.

Hon. Frank Cochrane's bill to supplement the revenues of the province placing a tax on mining lands will tion direct from the field. submitted to the legislature this week. The money, Mr. Cochrane told a deputation of mining men on Saturday, will be used in pant to encourage the refining and smelting of ores

in the province. The deputation was composed of men largely interested in mining, parmen largely interested in mining, particularly in the Lake Superior district, considerable areas of which were patented years ago.
