Chief that Premier Ross has already wrought. Mr. Whitney's proposal, however, is quite big enough to be of direct practical interest to fully a million residents of this province. One or two companies may have the right to develop power at Niagara Falls, and do so under most economical advantages. Still, ample opportunity is left for the province to go into the business on as large a scale as may be necessary. Let us see, then, what the proposition of the Liberal-Conservative party really means. It means, first of all, that the party, if elected, will undertake to put in a plant at Niagara Falls as soon as possible, and if it does so it will immediately have a valuable customer in the city of Toronto, which is about to apply for the right to distribute power within its own limits. If Mr. Whitney should be returned to power, and if he should carry out the policy outlined by Mr. Macombell in his amendment, it will not be necessary for Toronto to apply for the right to manufacture electricity. All it would require would be the right to distribute it, and even this is provided for in Mr. Whitney's platform. Indeed, Mr. Whitney anticipates the necessities of Toronto, and his policy covers all the concessions we desire in the production and distribution of electric energy.

Sault Ste. Marie, Feb. 7.—Frederick Schultz was hanged in the jail yard here this morning by Mangnan Radcliffe for the murder of Mrs. Craig on Aug. 7 last. He went to the scaffold with the same composure that he has shown all thru. On the way from the jail to the scaffold he met Constable Pearson, and said, "Good-bye, Mr. Pearson; I hope to see you some time again." On the scaffold, he said, "Here goes an innocent soul to eternity; that is all I have to say." Schultz had been known as Lindsay as well as Schultz, but confessed before death that neither was his name.

**PROTECTION OF PRESIDENT.**

Committee on Judiciary Presents a Report on Bills.

Washington, Feb. 7.—Chairman Day of the House Committee on Judiciary today presented the report on the bill for the protection of the President and the suppression of crime against the government. The report states that the committee has carefully considered the many anti-Anarchist measures and has sought to present a wise, conservative, constitutional and effective measure. The purpose of the bill was summed up as follows:

"First, prevent any and all plots to protect the President and Vice-President in the United States, and those by law in the line of succession to that high office; second, protect the Ministers and Ambassadors of foreign governments accredited to and within the United States; third, prevent the open and deliberate perpetration of certain crimes; and also certain unlawful teachings, which are permitted, disseminated and intended to breed lawlessness and crime against and culminate in the destruction of the government;
