Knowing how this government can take a precedent and write it all the way to kingdom come, I am afraid this is just a first. Shortly down the road it will be the postal workers, the letter carriers' union, and then the entire public sector will be devoid of any meaningful collective bargaining. I object to that. I object to what that is doing to the workers and the collective bargaining process.

At this particular time the government is talking about tripartism, sitting down to work things out, discussing and coming to agreements. But without any sort of meaningful collective bargaining, the government slipped a bill into this House which will superimpose a collective agreement on a group of workers. Thus, I do not hesitate when I say that my party opposes the action of the government in relation to this particular situation with the air traffic controllers. We will give evidence of the position we have taken by voting against it when the bill finally comes to a vote.
