Frocks for Class Festivilies

HILE the three gowns in the sketch were designed mainly for the college or school girl, who is, even now, planning her frock for the many festivities which take place during commencement week; they might also furnish ideas for Summer diance frocks. The figure on the right pictures an extremely dainty composed of innumerable tiny ruffles on a narrow foundation while the upper half is a full net puff held in place with a band of blue ribbon, fastened in front just above the knees with a pink rose. A wide soft panel extends from the knees to the line of the decolletage, where it is caught with nother rose; a blue satin waist band runs under this panel. The bodice and sleeves are merely a scarf-like drapery of the net.

The central gown 's of yellow chiffon taffeta, which, by the way, is the "dermier cri" in fabrics. The skirt is made with the bouffant bustle drapery. There is a girdle of black velvet and a shawl bertha of shadow lace.

The figure on the balustrade shows a frock of fleeh pink crepe de chine with a tunic and bodice of beaded tulle and a butter-fly girdle of pink satin.

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
